## 22nd April 2016. School's Folklore Day workshop topics

### 1st GRADE:

First graders were collecting stones, ropes, wooden sticks etc. which were used in traditional games. They demonstrated the games in a short presentation.

### 2nd GRADE:

Second graders were playing traditional games of our ancestors and they presented dance choreography of a traditional song 'Isla zena na gosti'.

### 3rd GRADE:

Third graders were playing traditional games of rock throwing, jumping in sacks, hopscotch, rubber band jumping game, making a wreath out of flowers, playing music on a leaf of grass, card throwing (traditionally called 'pickanje'). Every game had a winner.

### 4th GRADE:

Fourth graders were making traditional items out of modeling clay. They presented their work in a form of exhibition in our school.

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WORKSHOP WITH MRS. MARIJA ŠAVORA

Eco Day workshop with Mrs. Marija Šavora:

Parts of a folk costume:

POCULICA- a lace head decoration

ŽINJE- braided stripes made from horsetail

ZDULCI- a shirt that goes under the costume

PLEČEK- a shirt with puffy sleeves

FRAK- male winter jacket

ZIMSKI PLIŠNATI ANCUG- woman's suit with boots

SPODNJICA ( Z ŠLINGAMIN )- a petticoat with lace

PODROBAČA- a shirt that goes beneath the ceremonial shirt

GUZANJKA- pleated light skirt

KRATKI FERTO- short apron

DUDEK- final top part ( jacket )

GOMBOŠI- high shoes

POREK- the first part of a costume that goes beneath the dress ( for nicer a appearance )

TIBET- ceremonial scarf ( the final part of a costume )

ROBAČA I PODROBAČA- a skirt and a petticoat

DUGI FERTO- apron
